## Online Course: Go! Global virtual exchanges

### What is 'Go! Global'?

'Go! Global' is a virtual school exchange programme which gives pupils the possibility to share their experiences and thoughts on different topics across national borders. The programme addresses schools worldwide and thus contributes to a valuable exchange on a global level.

The programme facilitates pupils to exchange their practical experience related to the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), for example school gardening and food production or waste disposal and recycling. Those are topics that concern everyone – irrespective of their country of origin. Through virtual exchange pupils can not only explore common ground and differences, but also learn to recognize and analyse global connections, share their experiences with each other and gain new thought-provoking impulses for their own behaviour and actions on a local level.

### How does 'Go! Global' work?

Learners engaged in local sustainability activities have regular contact with learners from other countries over a period of several months. They communicate via different channels, such as video conferences or the exchange of self-made photographs and videos.

Therefore, 'Go! Global' empowers pupils to think globally and connect new experiences with corresponding actions on a local level.

Global Team of the ESD Expert Net are looking for teachers, facilitators, multipliers and all people interested in Education for Sustainable Development who want to be future implementers of virtual exchanges. If you want to learn how to do that in order to work with your learners and at least one partner school on topics related to the Sustainable Development Goals within a global perspective, you are exactly who we are looking for.

## Online course's general learning objectives

At the end of the course participants will be able to plan and implement their own virtual exchange in a Go! Global style

## Specific learning objectives

- You will develop competencies to identify and properly use digital tools such as, video conference, interactive presentations, virtual reality tours, etc. That allow you to implement a virtual exchange (VE) about a sustainability project that you are currently working at or planning to work at in your school/institution.
- You will be familiar with the basic concepts of Sustainable Development Goals.
- You will learn to develop creative ways to implement your VE.
- You will be able to identify the basic elements to develop and implement a VE.

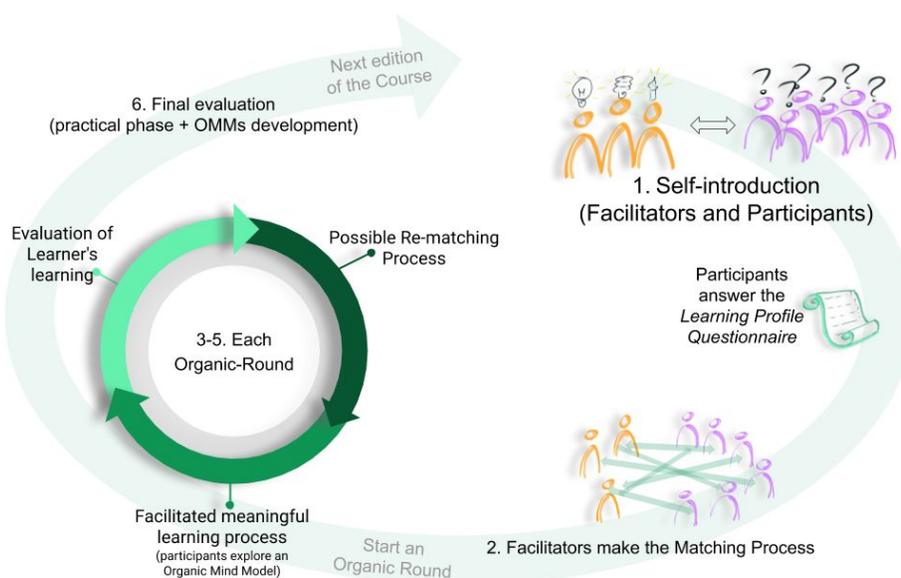
## Pedagogical approach of the online course

This online course is based on the [#OrganicLearning](#) approach. It is organic because participants will learn by exploring different graphical-interactive-digital representations (called Organic Mind Models) of what Go! Global is all about and how to organize that kind of virtual exchanges. Therefore, an #OrganicLearning Course, like this one, doesn't have a linear curriculum. Instead, we offer a diverse catalogue of Organic Mind Models (OMMs). Each of those OMMs has been developed by a different practitioner who have implemented Go! Global virtual exchanges since 2015/16. They have designed their OMM from their own particular perspective.

#OrganicLearning fosters a more meaningful way of learning because participants will be matched -after the introduction phase- with the facilitators of the course who have a more compatible profile depending on the interests and expectations of the participant. All the OMMs are very much interactive in nature, participants will not be alone. They will get consistent feedback from the facilitator. Also, by exploring the Organic Mind Model organically, based on their own interests, background, experiences, etc., they will experience learning in a more meaningful way.

As part of the evaluation of an Organic Course, participants will develop their own Organic Mind Models based on what they learnt and experience through the practical phase. Those Organic Mind Models could be part of future editions of the course, enriching the diversity of perspectives.

## Who are the facilitators of the online course?

## Participant selection criteria

Applicants:

- have to submit either qualifications, or experiences in educational work, that clarifies the involvement of the applicant to Education for Sustainable Development.
- have at least intermediate English skills
- work or will have the opportunity to work with a group of learners in order to apply what they learn during the online course
- submit a project description (500 words) they want to implement after the online course.
- have access to a fast Internet connexion (minimum bandwidth 2Mbps)<sup>1</sup>
- have a computer/laptop with Internet access, webcam and microphone.
- compromise for a working-load from 2-5 hours per week during the whole online course.
- must commit to finishing the course by submitting the [application form](#)

## Certificate

Participants who finished and approved the online course will get an official certificate issued by the ESD Expert Net (key partner of the UNESCO Global Action Program) as well as an official badge as Go! Global implementer.
